



The CFR is the codification of the general and permanent rules published in the Federal Register by the Federal Government. It is divided into 50 titles that represent broad areas that are subject to federal regulation. Each volume of the CFR is updated once each year and issued quarterly.

Titles are updated as follows:

Titles 1 - 16 : January 1st

Titles 17 - 27 : April 1st

Titles 28 - 41 : July 1st

Titles 42 - 50 : October 1st

The regulatory entity of Title 40 is the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).
Parts 1600 - 1699 address chemical safety.

The regulatory entity of Title 29 is the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA).
Of Title 29, Part 1910, Subpart H (Hazardous Materials), covers a wide range of hazardous substances and handling specifics regarding these substances.
